



Mumbai & Lonavala: City & Hill Escape

4 Nights / 5 Days

Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Mumbai

Arrive in Mumbai and check in to your hotel. In the evening, walk along Marine Drive, Mumbai's iconic promenade, and visit the Gateway of India lit up at night. Overnight stay in Mumbai.

Day 2 - Mumbai City & Elephanta Caves

Take a morning ferry from the Gateway of India to Elephanta Caves to see the ancient rock-cut sculptures. Back in the city, visit Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (a UNESCO site) and Colaba Causeway for shopping. Overnight stay in Mumbai.

Day 3 - Drive to Lonavala

After breakfast, drive to Lonavala via the Mumbai-Pune Expressway (approx. 100 km, 2.5-3 hours). Check in and catch the sunset at Tiger's Point or Lion's Point. Overnight stay in Lonavala.

Day 4 - Lonavala-Khandala Sightseeing

Visit Bhushi Dam and the ancient rock-cut Karla and Bhaja Caves, followed by an optional walk/trek up to Lohagad Fort. Evening free to shop for Lonavala's famous chikki (a local sweet). Overnight stay in Lonavala.

Day 5 - Departure

After breakfast, drive back to Mumbai or Pune for your onward flight/train.

Did You Know?

- Elephanta Caves, a short ferry ride from the Gateway of India, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site with rock-cut sculptures dating back to the 5th-6th century.

Travel Tips & Hacks

- Elephanta Caves ferries stop in rough monsoon seas (roughly June-September) — plan an alternate activity if visiting then. Lonavala is best for waterfalls just after monsoon (September-October).

Please Note

- Access to Lohagad Fort involves a moderate uphill walk and is optional depending on group fitness.





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
