



## **Seychelles Island Paradise: Mahé, Praslin & La Digue**

5 Nights / 6 Days

## Itinerary

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### Day 1 - Arrival in Mahé

Arrive at Seychelles International Airport near Victoria and transfer to your hotel. Evening at Beau Vallon Beach, Mahé's most popular stretch of sand. Overnight stay in Mahé.

### Day 2 - Mahé Island Tour

Visit Victoria, the world's smallest capital city, including its Botanical Garden. Continue to the Mission Lodge viewpoint and Anse Takamaka Beach. Overnight stay in Mahé.

### Day 3 - Ferry to Praslin

Morning ferry to Praslin Island (approx. 1 hour). Check in and spend the evening at Anse Lazio, consistently rated among the world's most beautiful beaches. Overnight stay in Praslin.

### Day 4 - Vallée de Mai

Visit the Vallée de Mai Nature Reserve, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and home to the rare Coco de Mer palm. Afternoon at Anse Georgette Beach. Overnight stay in Praslin.

### Day 5 - La Digue Day Trip

Boat trip to La Digue Island, explored by bicycle or traditional ox-cart. Visit Anse Source d'Argent, one of the most photographed beaches in the world, framed by giant granite boulders. Return to Praslin/Mahé in the evening. Overnight stay in Mahé.

### Day 6 - Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your onward flight home.

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- Best visited April-May or October-November for calmer seas. Seychelles is a relatively expensive destination with limited budget options, so it suits travellers prioritising a quieter, upscale beach holiday. Carry reef-safe sunscreen.
